Thank you Mr. Hibbs. I would just remind you that all (contemporaneous and full) reclamation work must be done in accordance with Appendix X of your MRP that deals with the gas vent well sites. I am pretty sure Scamp is very familiar with our requirements/standards. Weeds (particularly thistle) has been a problem up there too. One of your commitments in the plan is to continue to perform weed removal up there. If you could send me some photographs of the progress being made on each of the pad sites, that would be very helpful to me. I would like to aim for August in scheduling our annual inspection of the pad sites. Ideally, by then all the work will have been completed.

Thank you again for providing the status update. Please let me know when you estimate the work will be complete so that I may schedule our inspection.
