2. Signs and Markers

The mine identification sign is posted at the entrance into the mining permit area. The sign contains the required information.

The topsoil sign on the topsoil pile on the opposite side of the main access road from the road entrance to the main office has fallen down and needs to be re-secured.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The culvert outlet (CD-17) at the access road entrance into the lower loading pad is building with sediment and needs to be cleaned.

There is some sediment build up (DD-3) in the main road diversion just up canyon of the road entrance into the main office. The build up of sediment, rocks and wood is placed on a concrete pad within the diversion. The right side of the main access road looking up-canyon.

The culvert inlet (CD-5) at the road access to the main office is building with sediment and needs to be cleaned.
