Operation Plan

Topsoil and Subsoil

Analysis:

Section 333.300 describes fencing of active sites. A misunderstanding between DOGM and UEI has led to the following solution. UEI will use field fencing to protect equipment from livestock during operations. Topsoil that has been spread over the site during contemporaneous reclamation will be protected with vegetation. The Permittee will need to observe the site and ask the landowner to remove livestock or add fencing as necessary.

Analysis:

Section 341 describes fencing of reclaimed sites. UEI has fenced the following reclaimed/topsoiled sites to protect equipment from livestock during operations: 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17. Sites 1 and 5 were fenced for two years to allow vegetation to establish..

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Contemporaneous Reclamation General

Analysis:

Section 333.300 describes fencing of active sites. A misunderstanding between DOGM and UEI has led to the following solution. UEI will use field fencing to protect equipment from livestock during operations. Topsoil that has been spread over the site during contemporaneous reclamation will be protected with vegetation. The Permittee will be responsible to observe the site and ask the landowner to remove livestock or add fencing as necessary on contemporaneously reclaimed sites 3, 4, 5A, 6, 7, 7A, 9 and 11.
