The above-referenced amendment is approved effective December 15, 2014.

Andalex Resources Inc. will install field fencing to protect equipment at contemporaneously reclaimed sites 3, 4, 5A, 6, 7, 7A, 9, and 11. Contemporaneously replaced topsoil at these sites is protected with vegetation. The Permittee must monitor the vegetation for signs of overgrazing and contact the landowner to remove livestock or fence the sites. Final reclamation is not considered complete until equipment is removed and fencing is installed at these sites.

Sites 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 were fenced in 2014. Andalex Resources Inc. will remove the vertical culvert, backfill and grade at the following sites before applying for Phase I bond release: 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17.

This modification does not necessitate an update to the Technical Analysis. A stamped incorporated copy is enclosed for your copy of the Mining and Reclamation Plan.
