The annual report GVH commitment 'Not Met' box was checked, because there was no explanation of why the GVH sites that are not active were not fully reclaimed and fenced. You have just provided said explanation with your email. I do not expect you to re-submit the annual report. I will request that your email be sent to the Incoming file identified with task 5105, in order to tie it as a response to the annual report review.

In future reports, please provide the status of the GVH holes as well as the action taken or not taken to remove the remaining equipment. Please remember that the bond release clock does not begin until all surface equipment (pipes, culverts, solar arrays, etc) have been removed and the pads have received final reclamation. Therefore, it is in UEI's best interest to resolve this issue with Blue Tip.

Good morning Cheryl!

I'm going over the 2015 Annual Report Review that was sent over for corrections and I just have a couple quick questions:

I've never had to make changes to an annual report before, do I need to resubmit the report in its entirety, or only the section marked incomplete?

I visit and inspect the GVH sites a few times a year and check the fences to make sure the cows haven't knocked them over etc. The equipment hasn't been removed from the inactive partially reclaimed sites due to BlueTip Energy (formerly OSO) still has the main gas line that runs underneath them. The equipment on them is vents and things. The other equipment is theirs, so we cannot remove it. I've made several calls to them and David has written a letter suggesting a post-mining land use change to them but we have received no responses. I've chatted with Steve and Priscilla about a potential land use change and we all agreed this would be best, but just haven't heard anything from BlueTip. What do you suggest?

Also, there's 2 sections that a box wasn't checked either Met or Did Not Meet Requirements, the comments lead me to believe the requirements were met, but just for clarification, could you mark those? Thanks!

Let me know on the comment thing so I can get this resolved as soon as possible. Thanks again!
