In reviewing the above referenced mine permit, it would appear that there are several pertinent issues that need to be addressed to the satisfaction of this Division. These include all of the water right issues, whether they pertain to rights previously held by Sweets, from springs or Gordon Creek. Another concern includes the filing of R69 Forms for the sedimentation ponds that are proposed. Stream Channel Alteration Permits must also be filed for work that will impact any stream in the permit area. To date, we have yet to receive any of this information in a final form.

Mr. Roger Skaggs has been in our office many times over the past several months concerning some of these issues, however, to date none of them have been resolved to our satisfaction. As in the past, we would be happy to work with Mr. Skaggs to resolve these matters.
