Accompanying this letter is a stamped copy of the transmittal letter and Notice of Intent ("NOI") submitted to the Utah Division of Air Quality ("UDAQ") for the Horizon Mine in Carbon County. The submittal of this NOI is in response to the final condition of Division Order 99B.

Assuming that the NOI is complete, the Division of Air Quality should complete its review in 90 days. After the UDAQ accepts the NOI it will give the mine a permit, (Approval Order) to operate under the specified conditions. Upon the receipt of an Approval Order from the UDAQ three clean copies will be submitted to the Division for inclusion into the Horizon Mine permit.
