Kit,

Just a follow-up to our discussion last Friday November 30, 2007. PRWID (Price River Water Improvement District) expressed a concern that they had not received any gray water shipments from the Horizon mine for the last six weeks. Their records showed approximately three shipments per week at 3000 gallons per load, prior to the inactivity. PRWID was under the impression that the mine was idled due to the bankruptcy filing. PRWID concern is that the gray water is being disposed of properly. In addition to their notifying the Division they also notified the Department of Health. You indicated that the gray water is being transported to the consumers area where you have a (non mining) shop and being placed in the septic system. I requested that the shipping information be forwarded to the Division for verification. To date I have not received the information. In addition the following information should be provided. Is the septic system capacity at the shop area designed for this activity and approved by the Department of Health? The question arises does this activity constitute mining activity outside of the permit area, since this site is privately owned and not permitted by the Division?
