The Horizon Mining operation is operating and mining coal. This report is based on data compiled in file; O:\007020.hzn\Water Quality\datacheck 2007-2009(2).xls.

The water monitoring plan is outlined in Chapter 7 of the MRP. Surface and groundwater monitoring is required for the Horizon Mine under the operation plan. Kit Pappas is the contact for water monitoring issues.

Identify sites not monitored and reason why, if known:

Springs During the operational and reclamation phases the springs will be monitored once each calendar quarter when the spring are accessible. SP-1, SP-2, SP-4, SP-9 (Jewkes Sp.), 2-6-W (Homestead Sp.) And GV-70. Ground water quality parameters to be checked are outlined in Table 2 of the MRP.

Streams Stations SS-3, SS-5, SS-7, SS-8, SS-10 and SS-11 will be monitored once each quarter (as access conditions permit). Surface water quality parameters are outlined in Table 7-5 of the MRP.

Wells Water level data will be collected during the operational and reclamation phases from the HZ wells once each quarter when accessible.

UPDES Monthly monitoring of flows from mine discharge and sedimentation pond. The mine discharge runs about 350 gpm. The pond discharges continuously because of the mine discharge.
