Hello Priscilla,

We found a small patch of Black Henbane above the gate going to the Horizon Mine portal. Its on the left side of the road or the North West side of the hill. Black Henbane is a Class A noxious and invasive weed declared by the State of Utah and is not native to the State. Black Henbane poses a threat to the State and should be considered a high priority for control.

Attached is a couple of pictures I took of this plant. One is in the flowering stage and the other is a picture of the hill side where you can see some older plants that were there from last year.
