## **1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale**

The mine no longer has a permit to operate. The mine must immediately reclaim the site.

### **4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions**

It was difficult to discern the location of many of the ditches because of the deep snow pack.

### **4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments**

The pond appeared to have a water level that was lower than the spillway. This pond will discharge when the snow cover on the site and upstream of the site melts. The failed bypass culvert currently pipes undisturbed area runoff into the sediment pond. During peak runoff of snow melt in the spring, runoff from the the up-stream watershed will fill the pond to capacity and it will discharge through the outfall. Given the site appears to be abandoned, the discharge will probably not be sampled and reported as required by the UPDES permit.

### **4.e Hydrologic Balance: Effluent Limitations**

The pond receives runoff from the up-stream undisturbed area because the bypass culvert has failed. The pond is no longer sized to adequately treat effluent prior to discharging through the outfall. It is likely the pond will exceed effluent limits during spring runoff.
