This operation was inspected by ^JJoe Helfrich, Mary Ann Wright, and Tom Suchoski on November 15, 1979. The purpose of the visit was to determine the best way to bypass the natural drainages of Muddy Creek and Long Canyon for this proposed operation on fee land. It is felt that the Muddy Creek drainage should be handled with an oval or squashed culvert sized for a 50 year-24 hour storm. Long Canyon drainage, which will only be crossed by the access road, should be culverted at the crossing with a culvert sized to handle the 10 year-24 hour storm.

Mr. Harvey of Blazon Mining Company will be notified of this, in a letter.
