Mr. Scott Williams of Sanders Exploration, Limited and Mr. Joseph Harvey of Blazon Mining Company met with the Division staff on June 11, 1979. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the areas, in the Mining and Reclamation Plan, submitted by Blazon Mining, which the Division staff felt were inadequately covered. The areas covered were:

1. Hydrology - Lack of hydrologic calculations for sizing of culverts, sediment ponds, and stream diversions.
2. Water Quality - Urged to upgrade monitoring program to the requirements of the guidelines.
3. Alternate Water Supply - Require a plan for alternate water supply in the event that the local water supply is adversely affected by mining operations.
4. Vegetation and Wildlife Studies - Recommend the use of site specific data available from the Division of Wildlife Resources. Vegetation maps were requested.
5. Revegetation - Seed mix seeding rate was verified at 50 lbs/acre.
6. Soils - Need to set up test plots as soon as possible to prepare for reclamation. Soil survey needs to be done onsite.
7. Signs - Need signs designating perimeter, buffer, and topsoil areas. (For more detailed comments see comment sheets attached)

No commitments were received as to when or if this information would be provided.

Mr. Harvey was very concerned about the need to start construction soon as the working season is very short.
