Dear Mr. Smith,

Together with this letter, please find 2 copies of the proposed surface design of the mine. As you will note the necessary changes are being made as follows:

- 1. The access road to the portal has been extended up the Mud Creek Valley, crossing an 84" culvert over the creek and back to the north to the portal area.

The above change was required to keep the access road to a maximum grade of 8%.

- 2. The location of the water tank was changed to avoid cutting a stand of pines above the portals and combine the water tank and substation locations to minimize surface disturbances.

The access roads to the substation, fan and water tanks as portrayed will approach 20% of grade and will be used only for emergency access to the facilities.


- 3. The shape of the sediment ponds have been modified to fit the existing geology at the site. No other changes will be made.

A massive sandstone member will interfere with a hillside cut of suitable dimensions. This change will require two temporary creek diversions measuring 200 feet and 80 feet respectively as shown in darker lines on the print.

We are requesting your prompt review and approval of these necessary changes.

We will contact the local office of the Fish and Wildlife Division and use their input as guidance for the diversions.
