Dear Mr. Feight:

The following constitutes our response to your requested Pre-design Consultation in regard to this proposed mining operation.

It is our opinion that low level types of studies would be adequate for consideration of most animal groups for this area with the following exception. Intensive surveys to determine the presence and use of this area by raptors and other migratory bird species of high federal interest should be required.

A high quality vegetational map should be developed for the permit area. This would assist in the determination of the quality of the habitat within the mine plan area and would serve as a reference base for determining the adequacy of reclamation at the completion of the mining.


This mine permit area is located in the range of the following or endangered species.

1. Bald Eagle, Haliaeetus leucocephalus
2. Peregrine Falcon, Falco peregrinus anatum

The Company should ascertain whether any of these species do occur in this permit area.

This concludes our remarks in response to the Consultation for the proposed Blazon operations.
