

On October 10, 1980, Division members D. Wayne Hedberg, Joseph C. Helfrich, Thomas L. Portle and Sandy Pruitt visited the Blazon #1 Mine for the purpose of terminating three violations. They were accompanied by Joe Harvey (General Manager).

At this time, only one violation could be terminated. A sediment pond was being built and hay bales had been placed below the pad area. In addition, culverts and riprap had been successfully implemented. With regard to other violations, a new and acceptable site had been chosen for the topsoil pile. It was proposed to move the topsoil in the near future. The mine had until 8:00 a.m., October 31, 1980, to accomplish this.

With regard to the third violation, the mine had obtained samples for the purpose of proving that a 1.5 static factor existed, but had not yet submitted them to the Division.
