On September 18, 1980 a complete inspection was made by state and federal representatives, D. Wayne Hedberg and Eileen Doherty, at the Blazon #1 Mine site. Mr. Joe Harvey, Blazon Company representative, met the inspectors at the construction site and accompanied them on the inspection.

Diversion culverts had been installed in Mud Creek and Long Canyon Creek. A bypass culvert was being installed to divert drainage from Snyder Canyon under the surface facilities.

When questioned why the construction of the sedimentation pond had not been initiated, Mr. Harvey stated that unforeseen problems had arisen concerning proper sizing and placement of the pond and a variance was required from the State to divert a section of Mud Creek before construction can commence.

The topsoil stockpile areas are being consolidated and will be contoured, bermed and seeded this fall. Temporary measures to control runoff from the stockpile were suggested to Mr. Harvey of which he committed to implementing promptly.

Upon completion of the on-site inspection, the proper paper work and mine plans were reviewed at a temporary office in Clear Creek. Mr. Harvey was in the process of moving the appropriate plans from Ferron, Utah to the Clear Creek location and consequently a few materials were not readily available in Clear Creek.

Following the Blazon Mine site inspection the proposed Colton preparation plant and loadout site for the Blazon Mine was visited. It is located 28 miles from the mine site adjacent to Route 6, 1/2 mile south of the intersection with State Highway 96 west. No activity was present at the time of inspection, although some grading and leveling work has been done recently.

No state or federal violations were issued.
