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THE STATE OF UTAH TO ALL OPERATORS, TAKERS OF PRODUCTION, MINERAL AND ROYALTY OWNERS, AND PARTICULARLY ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 7 EAST, CARBON COUNTY, UTAH.

Notice is hereby given that tentative approval was given by the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining to Blazon Mining Company, P.O. Box 327, Ferron, Utah 84532 to commence Underground Room and Pillar Coal mining on Section 4, Township 14 South, Range 7 East, Carbon County, Utah. The name of the proposed mine is the Blazon #1 Mine, and the person representing the company is Mr. Joseph A. Harvey, President, Blazon Mining Company, P.O. Box 327, Ferron, Utah 84532.

Blazon Mining Company has fulfilled obligations under the Utah Mined Land Reclamation Act of 1975 (Section 40-8, U.C.A., 1953, as amended) and all applicable rules and regulations, and will employ the following reclamation and development techniques on 2 acres of Fee-owned surface acreage:

During Operations:

1. Operate in a safe, miner-like fashion in accordance with the Mining and Reclamation Plan filed with the Division.
2. Divert drainage away from mine site and detain runoff from mine site with a sedimentation pond.
3. Reclaim and revegetate all disturbed areas not required for mining operations.
4. Stockpile and revegetate topsoil and save for reclamation.

After Operations:

1. Remove all structures and equipment, and clean-up all trash and debris.
2. Regrade and recontour all highwalls, excavations, pads and rock-waste.

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After Operations:

3. Spread stockpiled topsoil; prepare, scarify, fertilize, seed, and stabilize as outlined in the Mining and Reclamation Plans.

4. Seal portals and remove explosive or hazardous materials.

Reclamation surety will be held by the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.

Any person or agency aggrieved by this tentative decision is hereby requested to submit written protest within 30 days of April 24, 1980 to the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, 1588 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah 84116, setting forth factual reasons for his complaint, and thereafter at a time and place heretobe established, appear before the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining, to show cause, if any there be, why this plan should not be approved.
