Dear Mr. Smith:

The Preservation Office has received for consideration and review  
the mine plan of the Blazon Company, Blazon No. 1 Mine, Carbon  
County, Utah.

It appears from review that the mine plan will disturb an  
untotaled amount of acres in T14S, R7E, Section 4. The section  
on cultural and human resources reads as follows; "The permit  
area does not contain any known historic or cultural values to  
be protected, which are not part of the mining operation."  
There are no sources of survey sited, nor is there justification  
for not completing a survey of the area. Our office files may  
be incomplete in this area, and therefore we are not able to make  
indications of what the potential for site location would be.  
Our office would suggest to the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining  
that this may need to be cleared up before the submission of the  
mine plan.

This letter is not to be interpreted as a requirement of the  
applicant, but this information contained can be used at the  
discretion of the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining.
