Dear Mr. Daniels:

We have received your approval letter dated May 22, 1981 and reviewed the stipulations.

No problems presented were insurmountable with the exception of Stipulation 5-81-5. We would appreciate consideration regarding the type of materials and the size of boulder requirements.

The first cave we encountered was 80 feet long 16 feet wide and undetermined height. It was necessary to move jointed rock 2 feet to 3 feet thick, 4 feet wide and 8 feet long. The reduction of this would require crushing or blasting.

We are not in possession of a crusher and blasting would create a serious hazard to the plant.

The waste has sufficient fine material to fill voids between the large rock and would provide adequate stability to the dump.

We await your decision and reply to this matter.
