Joe Harvey, president of the Blazon Company, was contacted by Joe Helfrich from the Division to inspect the proposed portal pad extension. At present, the extension is being addressed as a valley fill, with approximately 2,000 cu/yds of material to be used in the construction of the portal extension. Presently, the undisturbed drainages are conveyed away from the proposed fill area by means of diversion ditches and a 24-in bypass culvert running perpendicular underneath the existing pad. Mr. Harvey is in the process of obtaining additional information used in determining the stability of the original fill to be used as representative information for the proposed fill. The Division and the Office of Surface Mining will be making final comments on Mr. Harvey's proposal within the next month.
