Sandy Pruitt and Barton Kale of the Division conducted a partial inspection of the above mentioned minesite for the purpose of determining if any recent activity had taken place. The operation has been closed down since February, 1982.

No recent mining activity or development was in evidence although a front end loader has been parked there since the last inspection. The 12 inch culvert from the portal pad still needs to be dug out at the bottom end, as was noted in the last inspection memo. Also, a berm should be constructed along the drainage, by the oil can storage area near the shop.
