This is to advise your department that the Blazon #1 mine located in Carbon County, Utah is still inactive. As indicated in previous communication, the operation was temporarily suspended in January of 1982 and there has been no mining activity since that time. Efforts are continuing to develop an economically feasible plan to resume operations or to market the property to interested purchasers.

We are concerned with assuring that full compliance is maintained on all regulatory matters relating to this mine. We request that any deficiencies there may be, now or that may occur in the future, be communicated to us so the necessary remedial action may be taken. Our intent is to remain current in all aspects so the resumption of mining may occur with the minimum of delay.
