RE: Stipulations to Modifications
to the Mining and Reclamation
Plan

Dear Mr. Slalastog:

During the Division's review of the Permanent Mining and Reclamation Plan several stipulated modifications were found that have not had all of the stipulations fully addressed.

A list of unanswered stipulations is as follows:

1. May 22, 1981 letter addressed to Joseph A. Harvey from Ronald W. Daniels.
RE: Disposal of development waste.
 - 5-81-1 The applicant was required to forward to the Division within 90 days analysis of the underground development waste.
 - 5-81-9 Incorporate all responses and stipulations into the permanent mine plan.
 - 5-81-10 The applicant was to submit a plan for topsoil storage and redistribution. The topsoil storage plan was submitted but the redistribution plan was not.
2. October 15, 1983 letter to Kirk R. Harvey from Mary R. Bosworth Reclamation Engineer.
RE: Approval for installation of the 8' drainage culvert.

The applicant was to submit design specification for the inlet and outlet structures of the drainage culvert before approval for installation was granted. To the best of my knowledge no such design was submitted.

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3. December 1, 1981 letter to Kirk R. Harvey from James W. Smith, Jr.
Coordinator of Mined Land Development.
RE: Waste disposal at the Clear Creek Pit.
- 11-81-3 The applicant was to submit within 60 days a map of the disposal area.
- 11-81-5 The applicant was to submit within 60 days hydrological data listed.
- 11-81-6 The applicant was to acquire a variance to NPDES permit(s)
- 11-81-7 The applicant was to submit to the Division within 60 days an appropriate revegetation plan for the Clear Creek Pit.


The information required in these stipulations must be submitted plus incorporated into the permanent Mining and Reclamation Plan before the mine plan is complete for final approval.

In addition, the stipulations; 5-81-1, 5-81-6, 11-81-3, 11-81-5, 11-81-6 and 11-81-7, are past due and are subject to a Notice of Violation for operating without an approved permit.

Due to the circumstances that exist at the Blazon #1 Mine an extension of 60 days from the receipt of this letter will be allowed to fully address the stipulations pointed out in this letter. At which time all areas that have not been fully addressed will be subject to appropriate action by the enforcement staff.
