PUBLIC NOTICE

North American Equities NV has filed an application for a permit authorizing underground coal mining operations and related surface support activities, with the Utah State Division of Oil, Gas and Mining under the provisions of the Coal Mining Reclamation Act of 1978, (U.C.A. 40-10-1 et seq.).

North American Equities NV has business offices located at the following address: North American Equities NV, 1401 17th Street, Suite 1510, Denver, Colorado 80202, (303) 296-9441.

The proposed underground mining operation, to be called the Blazon No. 1 Mine is located in the West 1/2 of Section 4, T.14S., R.7E., Salt Lake Base Meridian. The entire permit area is located in Carbon County, Utah, approximately 0.9 miles SSE of the Town of Clear Creek, Utah in Snyder Canyon. The general area of the proposed operation is shown on the Scofield USGS 7.5 minute quadrangle map.

The permit area boundary is described as follows:

The point of beginning is the Section corner, Sections 4 and 5, T14S, R7E, Salt Lake Base Meridian, thence North 1° East 4000 feet, thence East 1210 feet, thence North 0° 30' East 1280 feet, thence East 1332 feet, thence South 0° 30' East 5280 feet, thence West 2615 feet returning to the point of beginning. The permit boundary so defined enclosing an area of 276.3 acres more or less.
