

A thorough tour of this inactive mine site was conducted by Sandy Pruitt on November 4, 1983. A couple of problems were noted needing immediate attention in preparation for winter. The berm located across the upper most cross culvert needed to be repaired to prevent any likelihood of off-site drainage. Also since the last inspection a small slump had occurred at the inlet of the ephemeral stream bypass culvert under the refuse pile. As this was a recent, natural occurrence causing the obstruction a violation was not warranted at this time, but it was imperative that the culvert inlet be cleared before snowfall so that the drainage course is clear for spring runoff.

Laura O'Kelly was contacted at the North American Equities office in Denver immediately following this inspection. She committed to arrange to have a local contractor maintain the berm at the upper cross culvert and clear the slumpage from the culvert inlet at the refuse pile no later than November 11, 1983. A follow up inspection would be conducted at that time.
