On September 26, 1984, I conducted an inspection of the Blazon Mine site and found that the culvert to route disturbed drainage from the upper end of the spoil storage area was completely plugged with water standing on the top.

As a result Notice of Violation N84-8-2-1 is issued for failure to maintain sediment controls. This violation has an abatement date of October 5, 1984.

To remedy the violation the inlet must be cleaned, and functional by the abatement date.

I notified Jerry Nettleton of ACZ Inc. of this violation and measures needed for abatement on this date.
