On February 20, 1985 I attempted to inspect the Blazon Mine to see if any activity had occurred since the last inspection. The weather was cold with light snow falling.

No attempt to clear the road had been made above the town of Clear Creek. Heavy snow drifts still cover the road.

As a result of research of the water monitoring data in their office, I became aware that no water monitoring reports for the mine had been submitted since the third quarter of 1984.

As a result Notice of Violation N85-8-3-1 was issued and reads as follows:

Nature of the Violation:

Failure to conduct surface water monitoring in accordance with a monitoring program submitted and approved by the Division.

Provision of the Regulation, Act or Permit Violated

UMC 817.52 (b)(1)

Portion of the Operation to Which the Notice Applies

Surface Water monitoring Program.

Remedial Action Required

Comply with sampling program as approved and submit results to the Division.
