Re: Blazon #1 Mine, ACT/007/021, Carbon County, Utah

In our telephone conversation of July 21, 1987, you requested clarification of the Division's position on post mining land use (post reclamation land use) for the Blazon # 1 Mine. As stated both in the conversation and enumerated in your approved Reclamation Plan, North American Equities has adequately addressed the regulatory requirements for post mining land use in the approved reclamation plan. As operator, North American Equities could apply for a change in post mining land use by amending the plan, but this would not further our mutual interest in achieving the items enumerated on the reclamation schedule, attached, during the 1987 field season. If there are surface owner concerns, regarding post mining land use, you might wish to remind the surface owner that the approved reclamation plan contains his letter consenting to the land use enumerated in the plan.

Alan, I hope this is the clarification you needed; should additional information be required please advise.
