Dear Mr. Smith:

Re: Transfer of Permit, Blazon #1 Mine, ACT/007/021, Carbon County, Utah

In response to your letter of May 19, 1987, sections UMC 788.17, .18 and .19 of the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Permanent Program Rules (rules) address requirements for transfer of a permit.

In summary, these rules require that an applicant for permit transfer (in this case Mr. Otani) must supply the Division with legal and financial information as required by section UMC 782 of the rules, must show that compliance with all applicable laws has been achieved in any previous coal mining endeavors and must show valid right-of-entry to the property. The new permittee must also provide a reclamation bond equal to the original bond and show proof of liability insurance, as required by UMC 782.18. The applicant for permit transfer must commit to conduct all operations in compliance with the terms and conditions of the original permit, unless changes are approved as per UMC 788.12.

The Division may approve a permit transfer after all requirements of the rules are satisfied and after a 30 day public comment period has passed.

With regard to the approved Reclamation Permit for the Blazon #1 Mine, the Division has noted that the office, bathhouse and shop building originally approved to be left as part of the alternate post mining land use has collapsed and is no longer suitable for the approved land use. Therefore, the Division will require that it be completely removed during the reclamation operations.
