American Equities, Blazon #1 Mine, ACT/007/021, Folder #2,
Carbon County, Utah

Attached are technical review documents regarding NOV N88-13-2-1 abatements and amendments to the Reclamation Plan as submitted on August 10, 1988, as well as comments regarding the Little Snyder Drainage design and other items in the Reclamation Plan which must be amended before final approval to complete the reclamation of the Blazon #1 Mine can be given by the Division.

NAE has also indicated that they would prefer clarification on the requirements to reclaim the access roads to the transformer pad and the water tank. Refer to those comments in the technical review memos attached regarding this matter.

In light of the short time schedule remaining to conduct reclamation activities, any commitments or revisions to the proposed plan and responses to deficiencies found in the technical review documents attached shall be submitted to the Division no later than August 22, 1988 so that approval of these changes can be made prior to commencement of construction activities which are required on or before August 29, 1988.


Revisions to the Little Snyder Drainage design have not been resubmitted to the Division in accordance with the request as indicated in a letter to NAE dated August 4, 1988. Please submit these data to the Division as early as possible in order that they may be reviewed and approved in order to meet the reclamation schedule provided in the plan. Other previous reviews by the Division have noted deficiencies in the Reclamation Plan but have not been addressed to date. These technical memos are also attached.

The operator shall provide two (2) copies of their submittals for review. Upon approval of the amendments to the plan, NAE shall provide five (5) final copies to the Division for incorporation into the Reclamation Plan.

Jack Otani, landowner, has repeatedly contacted the Division regarding work to be done on the Blazon site. Mr. Otani has requested that he be able to review and comment on changes to the Reclamation Plan. It is recommended by the Division that NAE coordinate these amendments to the plan in consideration of the landowner. If NAE wishes to meet with Mr. Otani at the Division offices to discuss the proposed reclamation work, please contact Lowell Braxton at the Division and Mr. Otani to coordinate this meeting. Mr. Otani has also been invited to come to the Division to review the plan at his convenience.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
