SUMMARY:

NAE (through Earthfax Engineers) has ordered the requisite number of Serviceberry seedling for planting next fall and has committed to plant them next spring in a timely manner.

ANALYSIS:

On June 15, 1989, I called Carol Bjork of Earthfax to verify that they had received my May 25, 1989 review memo, which requested that proof be submitted to DOGM by June 15, 1989, that Serviceberry had been ordered for next year's planting and a commitment to plant them by May 15, 1990. She indicated that the plants were ordered and a copy of the invoice and receipt for down payment were mailed to DOGM. Plants were ordered from the State nursery (Lone Peak Nursery). This information was received in DOGM's Salt Lake office on June 16, 1989, along with the commitment to have them planted by May 15, 1990.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The shrub contingency plan identified in the as-built report for the Blazon #1 Mine can now be approved.
