North American Equities, NAE, has declared insolvency and is unresponsive to all notices and orders submitted by the Division. Bond in the amount of \$38,000 was forfeited on May 31, 1991. The Division is currently evaluating reclamation treatments in lieu of the bond amount forfeited. The Division has met OSM Operations and Technical Services assist in design criteria for final reclamation work. No implementation of the industrial postmining land use has occurred since reclamation work was complete on the site in 1988. Currently, the landowner's desire is to have the site completely reclaimed to its pre-mining land use or that perhaps some settlement resolving his concerns can be made.

4b. Diversions -

The diversion contains rocks and sediment and needs to be redefined.

4c. Sediment Ponds and Impoundments -

Pond was not discharging at the time of inspection. Some erosion occurring at inlet to pond.

4d. Other Sediment Control Measures -

Silt fences throughout the property are not functioning properly; therefore, some sediment has entered the stream occasionally.

10. Slides and Other Damage -

No new damage occurred over the highwall.
