1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

Current status and information regarding the Blazon Mine site is essentially the same as the last inspection. Refer to that complete inspection dated 9/25/92 for detailed information regarding the status of the site.

No correspondence or other activity regarding the operation was found in the file for the month of March.

The site is currently covered with snow with depths varying from three to five feet. Access to the site cannot be accomplished by vehicle beyond the town of Clear Creek. No indication that any equipment or access has been made to the site via the only access road to the mine.

Evaluation of the site and conditions in regard to compliance with performance standards is considered to be in similar condition as prior inspections. Until such time as snow cover allows access to the site and runoff from snow melt occurs, no environmental or safety related conditions are apparent.

Note - This inspection report does not constitute an affidavit of compliance with the regulatory program of the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.
