## 1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

Current status and information regarding the Blazon Mine site is essentially the same as the last inspection. Refer to that complete inspection dated 9/25/92 for detailed information regarding the status of the site.

A letter written to the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining from Steve Tanner, Landowner dated January 25, 1993 was received by the Division on February 1, 1993. This letter was written by the landowner as a citizen's complaint. Response to the letter will be addressed by the Board.

The site is currently covered with snow with depths varying from three to five feet. Steve Demczak attempted access to the site on January 28, 1993 but access to the site was covered with approximately 3 feet of snow.

Note - This inspection report does not constitute an affidavit of compliance with the regulatory program of the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.
