1. PERMIT -

The mine has been classified as (non solvent) for the passed few years. There has been no action taken with the permit recently. There have been studies on further reclamation of this site.

4a. DIVERSIONS -

The diversions have not changed since the last inspection and are still out of compliance.

4b. SEDIMENT PONDS -

Sediment pond was not discharging during the inspection and no hazardous conditions exist.

4c. OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES -

Silt fences are still out of compliance. A request for the Division to demonstrate if silt fences were still needed was declined by upper management. Future action does not appear to be likely on this issues.

8. NON-COAL WASTE -

Power poles are still located in the stream passing through the mine site. It is unclear if a decision was made for the removal of these power poles as requested in the last inspection.
