4a. Diversions -

The diversions throughout the property are not in compliance; they are filled with sediment, rocks and wood debris.

4b. Sediment Ponds -

The sediment pond was dry and has not had any amount of water in the past few months. There are no signs of erosion of the inlets, outlets, or embankments. Pond appears to be stable with no hazardous conditions existing.

4c. Other Sediment Control Measures -

Silt fences throughout the property are out of compliance; they are deteriorated and lying on the ground. There doesn't seem to be any major quantities of sediment leaving the site.

Note: This inspection report does not constitute an affidavit of compliance with the regulatory program of the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.


