1. PERMIT -

The Board of Oil, Gas And Mining met with the Division and the landowner on January 24, 1996 to discuss the reclamation of Blazon. The Board decided that the Division and the landowner should discuss their differences to each other within 60 days. The two parties met on April 2, 1996. A further meeting is to be held but no schedule has been set.

The present bond amount is \$38,000 which is held by the Division.

NOTE: The mine site was inaccessible due to 36 inches of snow.
