As I am sure you remember, when I agreed to work towards a solution to the problem, Mr. Harden and Mr. Mitchell were to be included in the discussion of what would be needed to be accomplished during reclamation. Mr. Carter again ignored the past activities of UDOGM and your order to seek a logical approach to define a complete reclamation plan, and associated realistic costs.

Again, Mr. Carter chooses to white wash the issue by claiming we are the ones who caused the bond to be insufficient, leaving the Division blameless and guiltless.
