Enclosed please find Beaver Creek Coal Company's Mining and Reclamation Plan for its C.V. Spur Coal Preparation and Loadout Facility located in Carbon County, Utah.

This Mining and Reclamation Plan is being filed in compliance with the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Regulations, Permanent Program and the Federal Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977, Permanent Regulatory Program.

The document is being filed at this time in order to obtain construction approval for a new Truck Dump and Stacking Tube Facilities at C.V. Spur.

A formal submission of the C.V. Spur Mining and Reclamation Plan to both the Office of Surface Mining and the State of Utah, Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining will be made within two weeks of the date of this submission. At that time, a copy of the document will be placed on display in the Carbon County courthouse and a newspaper advertisement run in Price, Utah.

With submission of this document, Beaver Creek Coal Company, a wholly owned subsidiary of Atlantic Richfield Company, does not, and does not intend to waive or forego any of the legal or administrative rights or remedies available to it to contest OSM's jurisdiction of such facility (C.V. Spur) under the interim program or to in any way abandon the pursuit of its appeal of that Notice of Violation #N79-5-529 (N500446) issued September 20, 1979, for allegedly operating without an approved mining permit.
