Beaver Creek Coal Company, previously Swisher Coal Company, submitted a mining and reclamation plan for the C.V. Spur Mine on September 24, 1979. The Division staff had routed this plan for comment and review. This was completed late in August of 1980. On August 20, 1980, Arco Coal Company, the parent company for Beaver Creek Coal Company, submitted a mining and reclamation plan for the Castle Valley Spur as a permanent program application. On October 7, 1980, Beaver Creek Coal Company was contacted regarding the status of the plans submitted in 1979. Mr. Dan Guy indicated that this plan should be set aside and superceded by the Arco plan received in 1980. This is done by the Division by filing the old plan for review and comment as a past history with this memo. In all future work the plans submitted by Arco will be used as the mining and reclamation plan for the Castle Valley Spur. The plans submitted by Beaver Creek Coal Company will no be considered binding.
