This site was visited on March 25, 1980 by Mary Ann Wright of the Division, Dan Guy, Jim Ives and Dave Chenowith of Beaver Creek Coal Company and Arco, Clark Johnson of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and Larry Dalton of the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources, Southeastern Regional Office, Price.

The purpose of the visit was to do an onsite wildlife consultation. Both Larry Dalton and Clark Johnson committed to writing up their comments and sending them to the Division. The Division in turn has committed to writing a site specific guideline for the C.V. Spur and sending it to the Company. Overall, the general comments at this site from Mr. Johnson and Mr. Dalton seemed to indicate that existing information which is available on wildlife for this site will be adequate for inclusion into the mining plan.

Other observations made at this site were that the area was previously a salt desert shrub area and that the area was probably reasonably good raptor habitat, particularly for American Kestrels.

Two maps of this site were delivered to the Division of Wildlife Resources office in Price on March 28, 1980.
