The proposed permit area consists of approximately 160 acres of land of which practically all will be affected by operations during the life of the facility. Expected life of the facility is at least through 1997. Exhibit 3 "Refuse Disposal and Topsoil Stockpile Areas" shows existing facilities and the expected timing of use and extent of refuse disposal areas.

- 1.5-B Beaver Creek Coal Company proposes to conduct coal preparation and rail loadout operations at C. V. Spur for more than five years (at least through 1997).

However, the information required under 30CFR786.25(a) cannot be supplied as 786.25(a)2 is not applicable to Beaver Creek Coal Company.

1.6 Personal Injury and Property Damage Insurance Information

The certificate of liability insurance is included and follows sequentially.

This policy shall be maintained in full force during the life of the permit or any renewal thereof, including completion of all reclamation operations.

The policy includes a rider stating that "in the event of cancellation of the policy by the company, ten days' written notice of such cancellation will be given to the Regulatory Authority."




