Dear Ken:

Enclosed is the Office of Surface Mining's "approval package" for the C.V. Spur. Note those stipulations which were incurred. The Division has incorporated this approval package with all stipulations except the cultural resource steps into the Apparent Completeness Review we discussed April 3, 1981.

Please note those cultural resource stipulations which were placed on the C.V. Spur by the Office of Surface Mining. I gave them to Jim Dykeman, our State History and Preservation Officer (SHPO) who has reviewed and commented on the stipulations. I then sent Jim Dykman's review to Foster Kirby, an Office of Surface Mining archeologist. The general concern from Office of Surface Mining seems to be that there is no clear definition of a cultural resource site as used in the C.V. Spur survey. Foster Kirby felt that most of the stipulations incurred could be cleared up through the provision of a "site" definition.
