Enclosed is a copy of the C.V. Spur Surface Facilities Map which shows the proposed location of a steel diesel fuel storage tank to be used in conjunction with the new fine coal recovery circuit.

The storage tank is 16'3" long, 8'diameter, and will be buried 3' beneath the ground surface in an area that was previously disturbed. The diesel fuel stored in the tank will be pumped to the plant via a 3/4" inch steel line when the fine coal recovery system is in use.

The storage tank will be coated inside and out with a compound called gilsonite which will resist corrosion by the diesel fuel and the alkaline soils at C.V. Spur. The addition of this tank will not impact the ground water regime through loss of diesel fuel.
