Dan Guy called Sandy Pruitt on November 29, 1982 to inform DOGM that a coal fire had started on the Trail Mountain coal stockpile. Beaver Creek Coal Company intended to spread out the hot coal along the road by the Jensen Trucking yard to the southwest of the topsoil stockpile. Trail Mountain Coal will be temporarily stockpiled (for approximately two to three weeks) in a predisturbed triangular depression near the entrance. Mr. Guy alledged that all areas intended for use are predisturbed and drain to the sediment. If more area is needed beside the road for spreading the burning coal, the Division will be contacted prior to topsoil removal. These plans as discussed and described above were acknowledged with the request that Mr Guy ensure that all performance standards are met.
