Dear Mr. Hooper:


Mr. Joe Lyons has requested that I submit a letter to you, explaining our intent for handling of the soil for the plant overflow pond.

The proposed pond is within the disturbed area, therefore, no topsoil will be salvaged. We intend to use a portion of the excavated material to construct a berm around the pond. The remaining excavated material will be placed in the sub-soil pile on site for future use.

Upon final reclamation, the pond will be filled in, using the berm material and other available fill as described in our M & R plan. It is our intention to use a topsoil substitute on these areas where no topsoil was stripped. This will consist of material from the new truck dump, or from an off site location such as Four Mile Hill. As indicated in a previous response (1/14/83), chemical and physical analysis of the proposed topsoil substitute will be submitted to the Division in the near future.

It is our hope this response will satisfy requirements for approval of this project. If you have any questions or need any further information, please let me know.
