Dear Mr. Smith:

In response to your conditional approval letter of 12/28/82, the following plans are submitted to satisfy the stipulations of same:

- (1) Stipulation 12-21-82-1-JL - Plugging of Sampling Well CV-2-W.
Since the sampling well is very shallow (less than 8') and has been dry for a long period of time, it is proposed to merely fill the well tube with concrete to the ground level. Any remaining well tube above ground level will be cut off. The well location will be marked on a map, and a record of the plugging date and procedure will be kept in our files for at least two years as required.
- (2) Stipulation 12-21-82-2-EH - Topsoil Substitute
Chemical and physical analyses of the proposed topsoil substitute will be submitted to the Division no later than June 1, 1983. The substitute material will be of an equal or higher quality than that which is found at the proposed site.

Dear Mr. Guy:

The Division has reviewed Beaver Creek Coal Company's response to the stipulations associated with the Division's October 20, 1982 approval for the modification of drainage control at the CV Spur preparation plant. This response adequately addresses all stipulations except #4 and #6 which have since been discussed via telephone conversations between yourself and Joe Lyons of the Division. In order for Beaver Creek to satisfy the requirements of Stipulation #4, the design drawings submitted with exterior dimensions of pond #6 have been extended to 195 feet by 195 feet by 238 feet. This will provide a final pond capacity of 1.66 acre-feet using the additional criteria contained in Beaver Creek's response. Stipulation #6 is satisfied by Beaver Creek's designation of the maximum sediment storage level at one foot on the design received December 31, 1982.

Implementation of the above designs for pond #6 and construction of this pond according to these designs prior to May 1, 1983 will complete the approval of the response to the stipulations.
