Rick Summers and Joe Lyons met with Dan Guy of Beaver Creek Coal Company on Thursday, March 3, 1983 for an on-site tour of the proposed processing wastewater overflow pond. The current runoff control system was observed including the thickener pond, ponds 1-6 and the processing plant discharge point. Mr. Guy also indicated a small area between the road and railroad tracks near pond #6 for which a small area exemption has been requested.

Alternatives to the proposed pond were discussed and suggestions to place a filter dike in the pond and divert thickener pond overflow to the proposed pond were made. Samples of the plant processing water, inflow into pond #6 and outflow from pond #6, were collected and will be analyzed. Final approval of the modification and possible alternative measures will follow the receipt of the analyses results.
