Dear Mr. Guy:

This letter acknowledges receipt of plans for the Trail Mountain truck dump and stacking tube and for the western extension of the refuse pile. These plans have been forwarded to the technical staff for review. Upon cursory review the plans are deficient in regard to the following:


1. Specification of the present disturbed area acreage.
2. Volume of topsoil generated from the refuse extension.
3. Volume of subsoil generated from the refuse extension.
4. New dimensions required for spreading refuse (the 1980 map is outdated).
5. A demonstration that a two-foot soil cover over the refuse pile will not impede revegetation in accordance with UMC 817.111 - .117. This should include up to date (post 1980) refuse analyses to demonstrate non-toxicity. Also, an indication that sufficient topsoil is available to spread a 6" inch layer over the entire refuse area.
6. Specification of the type of equipment used for the spreading and compaction of refuse.

These are minimum permit requirements which the technical staff and I compiled to assist Beaver Creek Coal Company in the development of adequate plans (refer to letter dated April 6, 1983 items #1 - 4, 8 and 10). I recommend that this information be included in the ACR response due no later than May 16, 1983 so that the facilities can be permitted as expeditiously as possible.
